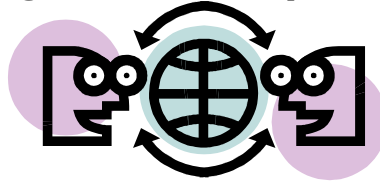


Tendring Older People's Forum
